RESOLUTION NO. 05-332

A RESOLUTION AS IT PERTAINS TO THE COSTS OF A PLANNING STUDY AND FINANCIAL FEASIBILITY ANALYSIS FOR THE WESTSIDE DEVELOPMENT AND THE ROAD IMPROVEMENTS TO WEST 7TH STREET (RANSOM HOWARD STREET)

WHEREAS, the City of Port Arthur Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors desires to continue its participation in the Westside Development project; and

WHEREAS, Dikita Engineering has presented a cost estimate to the Port Arthur 4A Economic Development Corporation for the following projects:

- 1. Planning Study and Feasibility Analysis for the Westside;
- 2. Road Improvement for West 7th Street (Ransom Howard Street); and

WHEREAS, Dikita presented to the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation a total cost estimate for the two projects at \$222,070 as described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the engineering fees for the road improvements for West 7th Street is \$72,070 as approved by Resolution No. 05-326 and Resolution No. 05-092; and

WHEREAS, payments of \$ 40,000 per month will be due to Dikita Engineering at the last day of each month for the first three (3) months as it pertains to the \$150,000 Planning Study and Feasibility Analysis as described in Exhibit "B". The final payment of \$30,000 will be due upon the delivery of the Final Planning document and Feasibility Report; and

WHEREAS, Dikita is also requesting reimbursement for travel, printing and other miscellaneous expenses as it pertains to the Planning Study and Feasibility Analysis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port Arthur 4A Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors, at their October 31, 2005 board meeting agreed to pay one-half of the cost of the projects up to \$111,035.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR:

Section 1. That the facts and opinions in the preamble are true and correct.

Section 2. The City approves the payment by the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation for up to \$111,035 for the projects.

Section 3. The Dikita proposal for the Planning Study and Feasibility Study for the Westside is approved as delineated in Exhibit "B" at a cost not to exceed \$150,000 with reimbursable costs not to

exceed \$22,508 as delineated in Exhibit "C", and with a focus on the study as to Section 4A eligible projects.

Section 4. That Dikita shall sign this Resolution agreeing to the terms thereof.

Section 5. That a copy of the caption of the Resolution be spread upon the Minutes of the City Council.
