THAT, the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute the first year of a three (3) year contract with Triangle Waste Solutions of Nederland, Texas attached hereto as Exhibit "B" for leachate hauling from the Landfill at a rate of \$52.00 per hour; and,

THAT, the subsequent two year's rate shall be adjusted according to the consumer price index (CPI); and,

THAT, funding is available in FY 2007 Budget Account No. 403-1274-533.51-01; and,

THAT, a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Contractor; and,

THAT, a copy of the caption of this Resolution be spread upon the Minutes of the City Council.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The intent of this INVITATION TO BID (ITB) is to provide bidders with sufficient information to prepare SEALED BIDS IN DUPLICATE for furnishing: TRANSPORTATION OF THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR LANDFILL LEACHATE TO THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR'S PORT ACRES SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITY ON HIGHWAY 365

Bids must be in a sealed envelope addressed to the City Secretary, City of Port Arthur, P. O. Box 1089, Port Arthur, Texas 77641. Bids shall be received no later than 3:00 P. M. March 7, 2007. Bid proposal MUST BE SIGNED BY THE BIDDER.

All bids meeting the intent of this request for bid will be considered for award. BIDDERS TAKING EXCEPTION TO THE SPECIFICATIONS, OR OFFERING SUBSTITUTIONS, SHALL STATE THESE EXCEPTIONS BY ATTACHMENT AS PART OF THE BID. The absence of such a list shall indicate that the bidder has not taken exception and the City shall hold the bidder responsible to perform in strict accordance with the specifications of the invitation. The City reserves the right to accept any and all or none of the exception(s)/substitutions(s) deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Port Arthur.

Bids cannot be altered or amended after submission deadline. Any interlineation, alteration, or erasure made before opening time must be initialed by the signer of the bid, guaranteeing authenticity.

The City reserves the right to:

- 1. Reject any and all bids, and to make no award if it deems such action to be in its best interest.
- 2. Award bids on the lump sum or unit price basis, whichever is in the best interest of the City.
- 3. Reject any or all bids and to waive informalities or defects in bids, or to accept such bids as it shall deem to be in the best interests of the City.
- 4. Award bids to bidders whose principal place of business is in the City of Port Arthur and whose bid is within 5% of the lowest bid price. This preference can't be granted for purchases involving Federal Funds.

The award shall be made to the responsible vendor(s) whose bid is determined to be the lowest offer; taking into consideration the relative importance of price, conformance to specifications and capability and experience of the contractor.

TERMINOLOGY: "Bid" vs. "Proposal"--For the purpose of this ITB, the terms "Bid" and Proposal" shall be equivalent.

Bidders are cautioned to read the information contained in this ITB carefully and to submit a complete response to all requirements and questions as directed.

<u>CONFLICT OF INTEREST</u>: No public official shall have interest in this contract, in accordance with Vernon's Texas Code Annotated, Local Government Code Title 5, Subtitle C, Chapter 171.

<u>ETHICS</u>: The bidder shall not offer or accept gifts or anything of value, nor enter into any business arrangement with any employee, official or agent of the City of Port Arthur.

MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR RESPONSIBLE PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS: A prospective bidder must affirmatively demonstrate bidder's responsibility. A prospective bidder must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be able to comply with the required or proposed delivery schedule.
- 2. Have a satisfactory record of performance.
- 3. Have a satisfactory record of integrity and ethics.
- 4. Be otherwise qualified and eligible to receive an award.
- 5. Be engaged in a full time business, and can assume liabilities for any performance or warranty service required.
- 6. The City Council shall not award a contract to a company that is in arrears in its obligations to the City.
- 7. No payments shall be made to any person of public moneys under any contract by the City with such person until such person has paid all obligations and debts owed to the City, or has made satisfactory arrangements to pay the same.

Any interpretations, corrections or changes to the ITB and Specifications will be made by addenda. Sole issuing authority of addenda shall be vested in the City of Port Arthur Purchasing Manager. Addenda will be mailed to all who are known to have received a copy of the ITB. Offerers shall acknowledge receipt of all addenda.

<u>PRICES</u>: The bidder should show in the proposal both the unit price and total amount, where required, of each item listed. In the event of error or discrepancy in the mathematics, the unit price shall prevail.

<u>PURCHASE ORDER</u>: A purchase order(s)shall be generated by the City of Port Arthur to the successful bidder. The purchase order number must appear on all itemized invoices.

<u>INVOICES</u>: All invoices shall be mailed directly to the City of Port Arthur, Attn.: Operation Center Dept., P. O. Box 1089, Port Arthur, Texas 77641.

<u>Payment</u>: Payment will be made upon receipt of the original invoice and the acceptance of the goods or services by the City of Port Arthur.

<u>SALES TAX:</u> The City of Port Arthur is exempt by law from payment of Texas Sales Tax and Federal Excise Tax, therefore the proposal shall not include Sales Tax.

<u>VENUE</u>: This agreement will be governed and construed according to the laws of the State of Texas. This agreement is performable in Port Arthur, Texas, Jefferson County.

<u>COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS</u>: The Contractor shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, rules, orders, regulations and codes of the federal, state and local governments relating to performance of work herein.

INTEREST OF MEMBERS OF CITY: No member of the governing body of the City, and no other officer, employee or agent of the City who exercises any functions or responsibilities in connection with the planning and carrying out of the program, shall have any personal financial interest, direct or indirect, in this Contract; and, the Contractor shall take appropriate steps to assure compliance.

<u>DELINQUENT PAYMENTS DUE CITY:</u> The City of Port Arthur Code of Ordinances prohibits the City from granting any license, privilege or paying money to anyone owing delinquent taxes, paving assessments or any money to the City until such debts are paid or until satisfactory arrangements for payment has been made. Bidders must complete and sign the AFFIDAVIT included as part of this ITB.

QUANTITIES: Quantities shown are estimated, based on projected use. It is specifically understood and agreed that these quantities are approximate and any additional quantities will be paid for at the quoted price. It is further understood that the supplier shall not have any claim against the City of Port Arthur for quantities less than the estimated amount.

All bids will remain in effect for sixty (60) days after the bid opening date.

If through any cause the Bidder fails to fulfill in a timely and proper manner, his obligations under this Contract, or fails to perform in accordance with these specifications, the City reserves the right to terminate this Contract by giving written notice to the Bidder of such termination and specifying the effective date thereof, at least fifteen (15) days before the effective date of such termination.

No person has the authority to verbally alter these specifications. Any interpretations, corrections or changes to this ITB and specifications will be made in writing by the Purchasing Division of the City of Port Arthur and sent to each person having a bid package.

The vendor must be an authorized dealer for all products offered. The vendor must give the manufacturers name and product description of all items. Inferior products, products which perform at a substandard level, or poor quality products will be rejected.

INCORPORATION OF PROVISIONS REQUIRED BY LAW: Each provision and clause required by law to be inserted into the Contract shall be deemed to be enacted herein and the Contract shall be read and enforced as though each were included herein. If, through mistake or otherwise, any such provision is not inserted or is not correctly inserted, the Contract shall be amended to make such insertion on application by either party.

<u>CONTRACTOR'S OBLIGATIONS</u>: The Contractor shall and will, in good workmanlike manner, perform all work and furnish all supplies and materials, machinery, equipment, facilities and means, except as herein otherwise expressly specified, necessary or proper to perform and complete all the work required by this Contract, in accordance with the provisions of this Contract and said specifications.

The apparent silence of these specifications as to any detail or to the apparent omission from it of a detailed description concerning any point, shall be regarded as meaning that only the best commercial practices are to prevail. All interpretations of these specifications shall be made on the basis of statement.

CITY OF PORT ARTHUR Specifications for the Transportation of City of Port Arthur Landfill Leachate To the City of Port Arthur's Port Acres Sewage Treatment Facility on Highway 365

General Information

These specifications are for the loading and transportation of landfill leachate from the City of Port Arthur Solid Waste Landfill on Highway 73, 1-½ miles West of Taylor Bayou Bridge to the City's Sewage Treatment Facility on Highway 365 west of Jade Avenue for disposal. No fees will be charged Bidder for disposal of the leachate at the sewage treatment facility.

Specifications

Bidder shall supply the following:

- 1. A minimum of one (1) 3,200 gallon truck, with additional trucks being available to fulfill the City's needs, with 3" and 6" loading and unloading capabilities.
- 2. Bid to include fuel and maintenance.
- Qualified licensed operators and any peripheral equipment (i.e. hoses & connections needed to connect to City's sludge handling equipment).
- 4. Current registration with TCEQ as a transporter of landfill leachate.
- 5. Company's permit numbers and name must be displayed on each truck.

Successful bidder shall work on an "as needed" basis under the general direction of the Solid Waste Superintendent–Landfill. Bidder shall use a City-supplied trip ticket showing time of departure from the landfill, amount of load, time of arrival at the sewage treatment facility, and a treatment facility operator signature. Trip tickets shall be submitted with billings. A typical workday shall be limited to 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Bidder shall provide a rate on the basis of a full truckload and on the basis of a partial load of less than 3,200 gallons. Bidder shall state any exceptions on the form provided.

The City estimates twenty (20) full truckloads per week and this is an approximate amount for bidding purposes only. This amount was determined from recent experience, and the City has the right to increase or decrease the amount of loads hauled as the landfill operations dictates.

All work shall be performed in the capacity of an independent contractor and contractor's agents and/or employees shall not be considered employees of the City of Port Arthur. Successful bidders shall be required to maintain public liability insurance in the minimum amounts of \$1,000,000 aggregate/\$500,000 per occurrence and automobile liability in the amount of \$500,000 combined single limit.

Successful bidder must agree to enter into a contract with the City of Port Arthur. The initial term of the contract shall be for one (1) year beginning after award by the City Council, and shall be renewable in increments of one (1) year for an additional two (2) years upon specific yearly approval by the City Council. Prices quoted for the first year of the contract shall be firm, and shall be indexed for the next two (2) years using the Consumer Price Index for a category of work comparable to this service.

This is not a contract for a completed project but, instead, shall be paid on a monthly basis for loads hauled within the previous month. The successful bidder's failure to perform the obligations of this contract in a timely and proper manner (as determined by the Solid Waste Superintendent) shall give the City the right to terminate this contract by written notice. Such written notice shall be given at least five (5) days prior to the effective date of termination.
