A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN ECONOMIC GRANT INCENTIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN LAMAR STATE COLLEGE - PORT ARTHUR AND THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR SECTION 4A ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the public interest to authorize the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation to enter into an economic incentive agreement with Lamar State College - Port Arthur; and

WHEREAS, Lamar State College - Port Arthur will provide 96 to 100 hours of construction worker training for plant expansions through the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Introductory Craft Skills Program to Port Arthur residents unemployed and under-employed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Board found that the training to be provided by Lamar State College - Port Arthur is suitable to promote business enterprises moving to or expanding in Port Arthur, particularly the petrochemical industries, who need skilled workers during the construction and operations of the petrochemical expansion; and

WHEREAS, the Port Arthur Section 4A Economic

Development Board has determined that a monetary incentive,
in conjunction with the job training grant program, will
attract candidates to the training program who could
otherwise not afford such a large time commitment; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2007, the Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Board approved a total expenditure of \$10,000 for job training to prepare Port Arthur residents unemployed and under-employed for job in new or expanding local industries; and

WHEREAS, Lamar State College - Port Arthur agrees to provide Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation record sufficient to show successful completion of the Program for student incentives; and

WHERES, the contract was approved by the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors Meeting on November 14, 2007.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR.

Section 1. That the facts and opinions in the preamble are true and correct.

Section 2. That the City of Port Arthur Section 4A economic Development Corporation is herein authorized to enter into an economic incentive agreement with Lamar State

College - Port Arthur and the President and Secretary of the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation are authorized to sign the agreement, in substantially the same form as denoted in Exhibit "A", attached hereto.

Section 3. That a copy of this Resolution shall be spread upon the Minutes of the City Council.

Executive Summary

The City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation ("PAEDC") Board has found that the training of construction workers for plant expansion is necessary to promote business enterprises moving to or expanding in Port Arthur, particularly new and expanded petrochemical industries. For that reason, PAEDC agrees to pay each Port Arthur resident, unemployed and underemployed, two hundred dollars (\$200.00) upon completion of the National Center for Construction Education and Research ("NCCER") Introductory Craft Skills Program ("the Program"). The maximum incentive funding by the PAEDC to the Training Grant Agreement shall be ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

Lamar State College – Port Arthur ("Lamar") has a plan to enroll those unemployed and underemployed Port Arthur residents in the NCCER Introductory Craft Skills Program for training as construction workers for plant expansions. Lamar agrees to provide records sufficient to show successful completion of the Program for training grant incentives.

TRAINING GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR SECTION 4A ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AND LAMAR STATE COLLEGE – PORT ARTHUR

RECITALS

WHEREAS, a major consideration for business deciding where to locate new or expanded enterprises is the availability of workers with the proper knowledge and skill set;

WHEREAS, Section 2(11)(B) of the Development Corporation Act of 1979 authorizes expenditures on job training by the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation ("PAEDC") if the PAEDC Board finds the expenditure to be "required or suitable for the promotion of development and expansion of business enterprises and other enterprises...";

WHEREAS, the Texas Workforce Commission ("TWC") has provided to Lamar State College – Port Arthur ("Lamar") a job training grant from the Skills Development Fund administered by the TWC;

WHEREAS, the Skills Development Fund will provide monies to provide training to qualified individuals for construction labor jobs;

WHEREAS, Lamar is to provide 96 to 100 hours of construction worker training for plant expansions through the National Center for Construction Education and Research ("NCCER") Introductory Craft Skills Program ("Program") to Port Arthur residents unemployed and under-employed;

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2007, the PAEDC Board found that the training to be provided by Lamar is suitable to promote business enterprises moving to or expanding in Port Arthur, particularly petrochemical industries, who need skilled workers during the construction and operation of the petrochemical plants;

WHEREAS, the PAEDC has determined that a monetary incentive, in conjunction with the job training grant program, will attract candidates to the training program who could otherwise not afford such a financial commitment;

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2007, the PAEDC Board approved a total expenditure of \$10,000 for job training to prepare Port Arthur residents unemployed and under-employed for jobs in new or expanding local industries; and

WHEREAS, the PAEDC desires to set forth in this Agreement the terms and conditions for PAEDC to provide a training grant to Lamar to provide a stipend to attract qualified candidates, who will be successfully placed in local industry.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

AGREEMENT DATES

AGREEMENT START DATE

1. This Economic Development Grant Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into with an effective date November 1, 2007, by and between PAEDC, with the approval of the Port Arthur City Council and Lamar.

AGREEMENT END DATE

2. This Agreement expires thirty (30) days after both parties perform fully the agreements stated herein, subject to earlier termination or extension, voluntary or involuntary, as stated herein.

PARTIES

- 3. PAEDC located at 4173-39th Street, Port Arthur, Texas 77642, is a not for profit corporation. It is duly authorized to do business in the State of Texas under Section 4A, Article 5190.6 V.T.C.A. (the Development Corporation Act of 1979), its Board of Directors has approved this Agreement, and this Agreement has been duly authorized by Resolution of the City Council of the City of Port Arthur. As so authorized and as provided by the PAEDC bylaws, the President and Secretary of the PAEDC Board have the authority to execute this Agreement.
- 4. The Lamar State College Port Arthur, P.O. Box 310, Port Arthur, Texas 77641-0310, is an open-accessed, comprehensive public 2-year college and a member of the Texas State University System, and its duly authorized representative for purposes of this Agreement is Dr. Janis Hutchins, Dean of Technical Programs.

CONDITIONS PRECEDENT

5. This Agreement has no legal consequences unless and until both the PAEDC Board and the City of Port Arthur City Council approve this Agreement in its final form.

PROMISED PERFORMANCE

6. The parties agree to perform as follows.

(a) PERFORMANCE BY PAEDC

At the end of each training session, and within sixty (60) days of being invoiced, PAEDC will pay each Port Arthur resident, unemployed and underemployed, two hundred

dollars (\$200) upon successful completion of the National Center for Construction Education and Research ("NCCER") Introductory Craft Skills Program ("the Program") at Lamar; however, in no case will PAEDC pay more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), which is sufficient for fifty (50) trainees.

(b) PERFORMANCE BY LAMAR

- (1) Lamar shall recruit eligible Port Arthur residents, unemployed and underemployed, for enrollment in the National Center for Construction Education and Research Introductory Craft Skills Program.
- (2) Lamar shall provide PAEDC proof of completion certificates for Port Arthur residents, unemployed and underemployed, and with reference to this Agreement.

PAEDC'S CONDITIONAL OBLIGATIONS AND LIMITED LIABILITY

7. The PAEDC's sole liability/obligation shall be to Lamar and shall be limited to the training incentive detailed in this Agreement. The PAEDC shall not be liable, in contract or otherwise, for any expense, expenditure or cost incurred by or on behalf of Lamar related to the training made the basis of this Agreement.

RECORDS/INSPECTION/PAEDC AUDIT

- 8. All records pertinent to this Agreement shall be retained by Lamar.
- 9. Upon written request, Lamar shall provide PAEDC with all reports reasonably necessary for PAEDC compliance with the Development Corporation Act of 1979 (Article 5190.6 V.T.C.A.)

CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS

- 10. Any alterations, additions, or deletions to the terms of this Agreement shall be by amendment in writing and executed by all parties to this Agreement and approved by the PAEDC, the City Council and Lamar.
- 11. Any alterations, additions, or deletions to the terms of this Agreement which are required by changes in Federal, state or local law are automatically incorporated into this Agreement without written amendment hereto, and shall become effective on the date designated by such law or regulation.

DEFAULT / TERMINATION

12. In the event of default of any of the obligations of the Lamar detailed herein, the PAEDC may, at its sole and exclusive option, withhold and/or disallow further PAEDC grant payments or incentives to the Lamar.

13. In addition to the foregoing, the PAEDC and Lamar agree that this Agreement may be terminated at any time when both parties agree, in writing, to the terms and conditions of any such voluntary termination.

ORAL AND WRITTEN AGREEMENTS / PRIOR AGREEMENTS

- 14. All oral and written agreements between the parties to this Agreement relating to the subject matter of this Agreement that were made prior to the execution of this Agreement have been reduced to writing and are contained in this Agreement.
- 15. Exhibit "A", Training Construction Workers for Plant Expansions, is hereby made a part of this Agreement for all purposes and constitutes promised performances by Lamar, in accordance with this Agreement.

VENUE

16. For purposes of litigation that may accrue under this Agreement, venue shall be Jefferson County, Texas, where substantially all the performance will occur.
