WHEREAS, a ballot proposition approved by the citizens of Port Arthur in May 2012 authorized the citizens, City of Port Arthur and the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation (the "PAEDC") to use \$500,000 a year for three years with an option to renew for three additional years 4A economic development sales tax funds for City Parks Capital Improvement Projects; and

WHEREAS, a request from the Dick Dowling Lions Club was made to improve Bert Karrer Lions Park in Sabine Pass and a request made from the City of Port Arthur to improve Lakeside Park as delineated in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, at the PAEDC March 3, 2014 meeting, the Board of Directors voted to increase the funding approved by Council to Resolution 14-054 by \$110,000; and

WHEREAS, as a result of said action, \$460,000 has been authorized for improvements to Lions, Lakeside, Lincoln, Montrose and Rose Hill parks; and

WHEREAS, the City and the PAEDC will work together to engage an architect to provide cost estimates for the park improvements as delineated in Resolution 14- 054 and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the public interest to authorize PAEDC to fund the improvements.


