A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE DONATION OF A 500K DIESEL GENERATOR FROM CHRISTUS ST. MARY'S HOSPITAL AND APPROVE A QUOTE FROM CAT5 RESOURCES FOR THE REMOVAL OF SAID GENERATOR TO A DESIGNATED STORAGE LOCATION FOR THE PORT ARTHUR SECTION 4A ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION; FUNDS AVAILABLE IN PÅEDC ACCOUNT NO. 120-1429-582.53-00

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the citizens of Port Arthur to create an environment that promotes business, entrepreneurial and community development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port Arthur is in need of dedicated space for the development of an emergency operations center; and

WHEREAS, Christus St. Mary's Hospital has donated a 500k Diesel Generator to support the development of the Community and Business Center ("The Press Building") for use at 549 4th Street; and

WHEREAS, the PAEDC Board of Directors at their Board Meeting of February 10, 2020 approved the quote with CAT5 Resources for removal of 500KW Diesel Generator and to transport generator to a designated storage location at a cost not to exceed \$30,610.13, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the facts and opinions in the preamble are true and correct.

Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Port Arthur hereby accepts the donation from Christus St. Mary's Hospital on behalf of the City of Port Arthur Section 4A Economic Development Corporation.

Section 3. That the City Council of the City of Port Arthur approve PAEDC to enter into an agreement with CAT5 Resources for removal of 500KW Diesel Generator and to transport the

generator to a designated storage location at a cost not to exceed \$30,610.13
