A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR SECTION 4A ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ACCEPTING A PROPOSAL FROM TOTAL SAFETY, U.S., INC. WHEREAS, Total Safety will provide technical specifications, project management, air monitoring services and a final report for the removal of asbestos-containing exterior vapor barrier mastic from select elevated exterior wall surface areas of the south side and east/west ends of the building, removal of asbestos containing window caulking from two windows on the east end of the building, and removal of asbestos-containing transit from the elevators shaft on the roof; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2020, at a Special Board Meeting the PAEDC Board of Directors approved acceptance of the proposal provided by Total Safety U.S., Inc. for the environmental consulting services for the selective asbestos abatement at 549 4th St. in an amount not to exceed \$9,990.00 as detailed in the Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR:

Section 1. That the facts and opinions in the preamble are true and correct.

Section 2. That the City Council hereby authorizes PAEDC to enter into an Agreement with Total Safety U.S., Inc. for environmental consulting services for selective asbestos abatement at 549 4th Street at a cost not to exceed \$9,990.00.
